NSCS Safe Learning Plan Overview of Plan Development and Summary of Public Comments

Plan Development:

Our Safe Learning Plan was developed in conjunction with guidance from Governor Walz's Executive Orders, Minnesota Department of Health, and Minnesota Department of Education guidance.

We surveyed families in May-June 2020 regarding our spring 202 distance learning process and seeking input to guide the development of our plan.

We convened an Advisory Team, comprised of staff, board members, parents, and our director to discuss the guidance and elements of the plan in preparation of opening this fall.

All staff and our Board of Directors were involved in review of the plan on multiple occasion.

Public Comment Period:

The Public Comment Period opened on June 3, 2021 and closed on June 10, 2021. We received two comments during this public comment period.

Summary of the Public Comments Received:

- The plan was well developed and a lot of thought went into it.
- There is hope for a vaccine for K-12 year olds by fall.
- A preference for in-person learning and no distance learning next year was expressed.

Additional Reviews:

We have reviewed the plan and made revisions in accordance with changes by MDH and MDE on 1-13-2022, 2-28-2022, 4-25-2022, and 8-22-2022

Public comments were solicited in May 2022 and September 2022. Comments received from the May survey were taken into consideration when revising the Safe Learning Plan in August 2022. Additional feedback was sought in September 2022 after the plan was revised. We received no feedback or comments during the September 1-20, 2022 request for feedback survey.
